Overview

Winston Churchill has always set the standard for excellence in academics, leadership, sportsmanship and athletics. The Charger Sports Association recognizes our extraordinary athletes with our Hall of Honor, created in 2005. The Hall displays some of Churchill's finest athletes, whose athletic feats extended beyond Churchill, into college and professional arenas. A designated committee consisting of coaches, association officers, administrators, and community members will select honorees every two years. The Hall of Honor showcases these distinguished athletes and will provide an inspiration to all the athletes that comes to Churchill high school. Charger athletes will maintain Churchill's "tradition of excellence" as they preserve the past, affirm the present, and shape the future.

Nomination Criteria

- Open to male and female athletes.
- Must be a WCHS graduate and will not be considered until they are 5 years past their graduation.
- No coaches or administrators will be considered for the Hall.
- Achievements should be extraordinary and documented by reputable sources of information, such as:
 - High School All State Athlete or State Champion
 - High School All American
 - Collegiate All American
 - Collegiate Division Honors
 - Professional Athlete
 - Professional Championship Team
 - Olympic Medal Winner
 - National USA team
- Contributions to the community – Past and Present.
- Honorees will be inducted every two years, consisting of a minimum of one athlete and not to exceed two.

Nominating Procedure

- Nomination applications will be sent to coaches, CSA Executive board members, Sports Representatives, WCHS principal, athletic coordinator, or assistant athletic coordinator.
- Forms must be returned to WCHS by April 1 and nominees will be selected May 1, for induction the following school year.
- The nominating Committee will meet in April to vote on inductees on May 1.
- The WCHS Athletic Coordinator will notify recipients of the honor by phone and email.
- The CSA president will send a congratulatory letter and information pertaining to the Hall of Honor induction ceremony, schedule of events, and requests for personal/professional and biographical information.
- Nominations may be submitted throughout the year to be considered for induction. Nominees not chosen will remain eligible for consideration in future years.
